Open Competitive Examination for the Recruitment of Graduates on District - Basis to the Class 3 Grade I (A) of Sri Lanka Teachers' Service for the existing vacancies in the Provincial Council Schools of the North Western Province - 2024

ONLINE applications are hereby invited from the eligible graduates as per this announcement and the Service Minute of Sri Lanka Teacher's Service of the North Western Provincial Council Public Service, for recruitment of teachers on a district basis to the existing vacancies of Class 3 Grade I (A) of Sri Lanka Teacher's Service in the Provincial Council Schools of the North Western Province.

- 01. This recruitment is done in Sinhala, Tamil and English Medium Subjects and a candidate can apply for a maximum of 03 subjects mentioned in the schedule. Even if a candidate has not applied for the primary subject, he/she will be considered for a primary appointment with his/her consent if he/she is qualified for primary but not selected for any of his/her choices.
- 02. I. Residents of Kurunegala district should apply for subject vacancies in Kurunegala district and residents of Puttalam district should apply for subject vacancies in Puttalam District.
 - II. Residents of the respective district will be given priority in recruitment.
 - III. Only in cases where there are not enough qualified candidates to fill the vacancies in one district, the vacancies will be filled from the qualified candidates for the same subjects in the other district.
- 03. A list of subjects having vacancies in Sinhala, Tamil, and English language media in each district is given in the schedule. The number of vacancies will be determined by the Public Service Commission of the North Western Provincial Council.

04. The Salary Scale:

The salary scale applicable to this post is Rs. 31,490 - 6x445 - 7x525 - 2x600 - Rs. 39,035/- monthly combined salary scale in Segment G.E.1-2016-A of the Public Administration Circular No. 03/2016(IV) dated 05.01.2022. Salaries will be paid placing on the salary step of Rs. 37,835/-, the fourteenth step of this salary scale.

05. Educational and Other Qualifications:

- 5.1 Educational Qualifications:
 - I. Having a degree related to the subjects mentioned in the Schedule from a university or Degree Awarding Institute recognized by the University Grants Commission, which falls under specialized subject areas recognized for teaching purposes, or having completed the four-year Higher National Diploma in Accountancy (HNDA) offered through the Sri Lanka Technical College or Sri Lanka Institute of Advanced Technological Education (SLIATE) as per the Pub. Ad. Circular 46/90.

and

II. Having passed Sinhala Language or Tamil Language along with Mathematics as a subject in the G.C.E. Ordinary Level Examination.

Very Important: The following should be considered when filling out the online applications.

- All qualifications must be fulfilled by the closing date of applications
- Candidates should pay attention to the subjects they can apply for based on their degree
- When applying for subject vacancies, candidates should focus on the main subject/subjects they studied for the degree. If a four-year degree is obtained, it is sufficient to have studied the relevant subject as a main subject throughout the first 03 years
- Only one online application can be submitted under one National Identity Card number. So before applying, check that the information entered is correct. The PDF file of the online application should be downloaded and its hard copy should be taken.

5.2 Physical and Mental Fitness:

Every applicant should be physically and mentally fit enough to perform duties as a teacher.

5.3 Age:

Applicant's age as of the closing date of applications should be at least 18 years and not exceed 40 years.

5.4 Other Qualifications:

- I. The applicant must be a citizen of Sri Lanka and a permanent resident of the North Western Province.
- II. The applicant should have excellent moral character and physical fitness.
- III. Should be able to serve in any area of North Western Province.
- IV. Residency should be proved at the interview by a DS 04 certificate issued by Grama Niladhari to be a permanent resident in the North-Western Province for at least 03 consecutive years by the closing date of applications. Applicants who have less than 03 consecutive years of permanent residence in the North-Western Province by the closing date of applications must also confirm their period of residence through a DS 04 Grama Niladhari Certificate.
- V. In cases where the permanent residence of the applicant is less than 03 consecutive years in the North Western Province by the closing date of applications, those applicants will also be considered as per Section IV above, if the applicant's spouse has got permanent residence in the North Western Province for at least 03 previous consecutive years. The spouse's residential certificate (DS 04) along with the marriage certificate should be produced at the time of the interview.

06. Conditions of Service :

- I. Selected graduate applicants will be appointed to the post of Class 3 Grade I (A) of the Sri Lanka Teachers' Service subject to the general conditions which govern the appointments to the public/provincial public service, conditions stipulated by the Sri Lanka Teachers' Service Minute in North Western Provincial Public Service and to the amendments to same which have been made already or will be made in future.
- II. This post is permanent. Appointees will be subjected to a policy decision taken by the Government about the pension scheme entitled for this post.
- III. Appointees will be subjected to a probation period of 03 years.

- IV. Promotions will be made in terms of the Service Minute of Sri Lanka Teachers' Service in the North Western Provincial Public Service.
- V. The Second Language competency level applicable to the post according to the Public Administration circular No. 18/2020 dated 16.10.2020 should be obtained within 03 years from the date of appointment.
- VI. Appointees should serve at least 06 years in the educational zone of the school to which the first appointment is given and cannot request transfers during those 06 years.
- VII. If the school of first appointment is not difficult or very difficult, such appointees are bound to serve in a difficult or very difficult school for at least 05 years at any time during their period of service.

07. Recruitment:

7.1 Method of Recruitment :

The recruitment is done under the provisions in the Service Minute of Sri Lanka Teacher's Service of the North Western Provincial Council Public Service and the approval of the Hon. Governor of the North Western Province.

7.2 Written Examination : This written examination consists of two (02) papers.

Syllabus

Subject No. 01 - Aptitude Test

This question paper will be prepared to test the skills and logical intelligence of the applicants. This paper will comprise 50 multiple-choice and short-answer questions. (02 marks for each question and the total marks is 100)

Subject No. 02 - General Knowledge

This paper will comprise 50 multiple-choice questions to test the general knowledge in social, economic, and political areas. (02 marks for each question and the total marks is 100)

- 7.3 *Examination Procedure:*
 - I. You can apply for this exam in Sinhala, Tamil, or English medium.
 - II. Every applicant must appear for both (02) papers.
 - III. Every applicant should appear in all the papers of this examination in one language medium. That language medium should be the language medium in which the applicant intends to get his/her appointment.
 - IV. Applicants applying for English subject must sit for the examination in English medium.
 - V. An applicant will not be permitted to change the medium of language indicated in his/her application at a later stage.

7.4 The interview and the Practical Test.

As approved by the Hon. Governor, three times the number of existing vacancies for each subject will be called for the interview and the practical test at once, based on the rank of the marks obtained at the written examination. It is mandatory for all the candidates appearing for the interview to appear for the practical test.

- I. At the interview, it will be checked whether the applicant has met the qualifications mentioned in this *gazette* notice for the subject/subjects that he/she was called. Further, marks will be awarded as follows, for the class of the degree and additional qualifications.
 - (a). Allocation of Marks for the class of the degree (Maximum Marks 07)

09. *Method of Selection:*

(a) Selection will be done under the provisions of the Teachers' Service Minute of the North Western Provincial Public Service.

(b) If an applicant is qualified for more than one subject that he/she applied for, the North Western Provincial Council Public Service Commission will decide whether to which subject he/she will be appointed.

10. Examination Fee:

A sum of Rs. 1200/- as the examination fee should be paid to any Divisional Secretariat in North Western Province to be credited to Revenue Head 2003-02-13 of the North Western Provincial Council and the receipt W.P.S.M.02 obtained from the Divisional Secretariat in favor of the applicant's name should be affixed at the relevant place of the downloaded application. Receipts obtained by debiting to other institutions or Money Orders or Money will not be accepted other than W.P.S.M.02 receipt. Such applicants will not be allowed to sit for the examination. It should be noted that the examination fee is non-refundable under any circumstance and examination fees paid will not be allowed to transfer to any other examination. 13. Identity of the Applicants:

 - *Note:* Applicants will be considered to be ineligible for the examination if they fail to prove their identity at the examination hall.
- 14. Applications should be filled with due consideration providing accurate information. Information will not be allowed to be altered under any circumstances. Suppose an applicant is found to be ineligible for written examination, the interview, or the practical test as per the regulations of this recruitment. In that case, his / her candidature must be cancelled at any stage. Suppose it is found that an applicant has furnished false information or intentionally omitted accurate information after getting the appointment as a teacher. In that case, he/she shall be liable for dismissal or termination from the Public Service at any time.
- 15. An admission card for the examination will be issued to the applicants who have paid the examination fee and submitted the online application and the printed copy on or before the due date, by the Secretary of North Western Provincial Public Service Commission, on the presumption that they have fulfilled the required qualifications mentioned in the notification. Once the admission cards are issued, a notice will be published on the official website of the North Western Provincial Council Public Service Commission (<u>www.psc.nw.gov.lk</u>). If the admission is not received at least 03 days before the written examination date, it should be immediately informed to the Exams division of the North Western Provincial Public Services Commission.
 - *Note:* As the lists of applicants qualified for interviews and practical tests are published only on the official website of the North Western Provincial Council Public Service Commission (www.psc.nw.gov.lk), the applicants should visit the website regularly.
